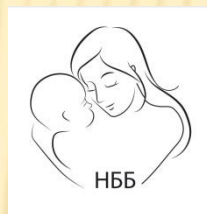

PARTNERS

- ✘ Zavod Samostojen from Slovenia is carrying out the project “Društvo taboriščnikov – ukradenih otrok” which addresses the issue of stolen children of migrants
- ✘ Will be in charge of sending a joint statement to the European Union at the end of the project
- ✘ Germany participates with the project "Geraubte Kinder - Vergessen opfer", which deals with the issue of children stolen during the World War II and organizes meetings between child victims of modern wars and people who were stolen as children during the World War II

“ARE YOU REALY HEARING THE CRYING?”

- ✘ Serbia participates with the project “Can you hear the babies crying?”, which address the issue of stolen newborns from maternity wards in Belgrade
- ✘ The events promotes the Proclamation of the European Charter of Human Rights and principles of the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, especially Women adopted by the United Nations under the 2000 Palermo Convention
- ✘ Main of Advocacy goal of the Missing Babies of Belgrade Association was and still is to convince the state institutions to deal with this particular type of crime, and not to underestimate its social danger

VICTIMS / WITNESSES APPROACH

- Starting from 80-s a declarations, conventions and recommendations, that set standards of services and assistance for victims/witnesses:
 - UN Declaration of Basic Principles of Justice for Victims of Crime and Abuse of Power;
 - COE Convention on State Compensation to Victims of Violent Crimes;
 - COE Recommendation about the Protection of Witnesses and Collaborators of Justice;
 - COE Recommendation about Assistance to Crime Victims.

“ARE YOU REALY HEARING THE CRYING?”

- ✘ Reading international training manuals for police and crime inspectors who deal with this type of crime, brings to light devastating facts. Compared to arms or drug trafficking, it is evident that trafficking in human beings is more profitable.
- ✘ Serbia's project “Can you hear the babies crying?” deals with the theft of newborns from maternity wards in Belgrade. The first cases of missing babies in Serbia occurred in the 1960s, but most cases date from the 1970s and 1980s.
- ✘ According to the parents, from the 1960s onward, newborns were stolen after they were declared dead under suspicious circumstances, without providing death certificates or other accompanying documentation.

MESSAGES TO THE AUTHORITIES

- ✘ Parents-victims believe that the state must have a comprehensive strategy in place to prevent trafficking and sexual exploitation of children and exploitation of women in childbirth
- ✘ To the extent that this harmful phenomenon has occurred as a result of improper conduct of the bureaucracy, it must be legally eliminated
- ✘ Trafficking in human beings coupled with corruption hinders the fight against this type of crime
- ✘ The strategic goal is to improve the national mechanism for identification, assistance and protection of victims.

THE RESULT OF THE IMPACT

✘ On 29 February 2020 the Assembly of Serbia adopted the Law on Missing Babies, originally entitled the “Law on Determining the Facts on the Status of Newborn Children Suspected of Missing from Maternity Wards in the Republic of Serbia”. The law should make it possible for the truth to come out about the missing children.

“ARE YOU REALY HEARING THE CRYING?”

- ✘ The Association **Missing Babies of Belgrade** is founded in 2018. The Association has been established with the objective to work as a regulatory agency of civil society and it was founded to propose the adoption of Laws, Bylaws and Rule of Law.
- ✘ The President Mrs. Milena Jankovic is the leader and the mother that went through all the horror that a mother can experience in a maternity hospital. It gave her the strength to continue the fight for the truth. As a lawyer and someone who knows the law, the founding of the association was a logical consequence of continuing the struggle for the truth.

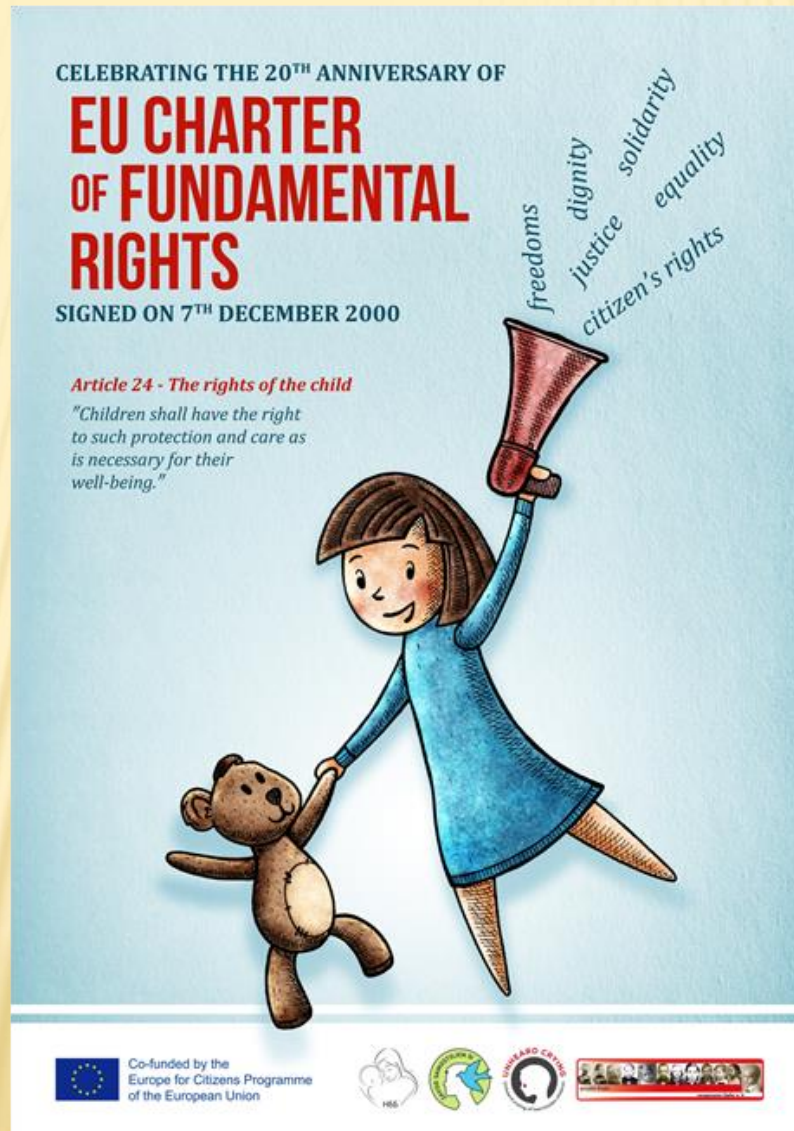

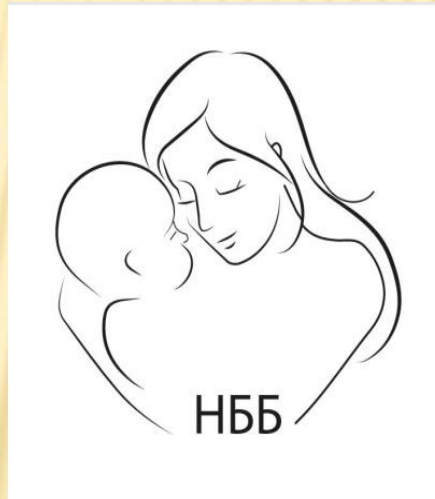
